It has a value of **six credits**, consisting of **30 contact** and **30 non-contact hours** (formerly guided learning hours), which is assessed by candidates completing two assignments, one theory and one practical, both of which are broken down into smaller, prescriptive assignment tasks.

The cost of the course is only £650.00 Ex Vat per delegate.
